### **C-10 Competition Finance Policy**

**Committee Responsible:** Competition

#### **PURPOSE:**

- To overview competition revenue and expenses that are covered by the CURLSASK
- To outline funding provided to teams attending Curling Canada's sanctioned national events and non-sanctioned events.
- To provide a guideline for outfitting teams in provincial clothing that are representing Saskatchewan at National events.

#### **POLICY:**

##### **Provincial Competition Revenue**

- The CURLSASK Competition Committee, in consultation with the Finance and Audit Committee, will set an entry fee for all competitions and provincial selection camps ran by the CURLSASK.
- Entry fees will be reviewed yearly.

##### **Refund/Cancellation**

- Any team that cancels prior to the registration deadline will receive a full refund of the competition registration fees.
- Any team that cancels after the registration deadline will receive no refund of competition registration fees. Under special circumstances written application for refund can be made to the CURLSASK Competition Committee for consideration

##### **Arrears by Player Members**

- Any player member who is in arrears with CURLSASK for more than 6 months of original invoice date, will receive notification that they are ineligible to compete in CURLSASK sanctioned competitions until the overdue amount is paid in full.

##### **Provincial Competition Expenses**

- The CURLSASK Competition Committee will budget for expenses accordingly for each competition in consultation with the Finance and Audit Committee.

- Provincial Participant Crests will be provided by CURLSASK to Juniors and Juvenile competitions, unless already provided by the event sponsor.
- All other competitions will only have winning team or provincial competitor crests if the costs for those crests are covered by the event sponsor.
- Provincial Winning Team Banners
  - CURLSASK will negotiate with any event title sponsor to produce and pay for a Provincial Winning Team Banner. The banner will include team names, home curling club and sponsor logo, to be hung in the team's home curling club.
  - Any competition that has no sponsor or the title sponsor does not cover the cost of the production of the banner, the home Curling Club or Associate Member can request and pay for the banner to be produced.

### **CURLSASK Provincial Champion Teams Clothing and Funding**

- Men, Women, Junior Men, Junior Women, Wheelchair:
  - Team members and approved certified coaches will be provided one (1) on-ice jacket complete with last name and provincial shield and two (2) on-ice shirts with last name at no cost, unless provided by the National Event.
  - Team members and approved certified coaches will be provided a \$150.00 grant per team member for the purchase of matching team outfits for wear at Canadian Championship, to be worn as directed by the Curling Canada Competitor Guide off-ice wear for team(s) representing CURLSASK at a sanctioned Curling Canada Championship.
  - No additional funding will be provided to the team to attend the Championship
- Mixed, Senior Men, Senior Women:
  - Team members will be provided one (1) on-ice jacket complete with last name and provincial shield and two (2) on-ice shirts with last name at no cost, unless provided by the National Event.
  - Team members will be provided a \$150.00 grant per team member for the purchase of matching team outfits for wear at Canadian Championship, to be worn as directed by the Curling Canada Competitor Guide off-ice wear for team(s) representing CURLSASK at a sanctioned Curling Canada Championship.
  - Approved certified coaches can purchase on-ice jackets and on-ice shirts at cost for the event. They would be provided the provincial back shield at no cost.
  - No additional funding will be provided to the team to attend the Championship
- Master Men, Master Women:
  - Team members will be provided one (1) on-ice jacket complete with last name and provincial shield and two (2) on-ice shirts with last name at no cost, unless provided by the National Event.
  - Approved certified coaches can purchase on-ice jackets and on-ice shirts at cost for the event. They would be provided the provincial back shield at no cost.
  - Teams would receive the following additional funding to participate in the National Championship
    - Canadian Masters held in Saskatchewan - \$1000/team
    - Canadian Masters held in Alberta or Manitoba - \$2000/team
    - Canadian Masters held in any other province/territory - \$2500/team
- Canada Winter Games Men and Women Teams:
  - Team members and approved certified coaches will be provided one (1) on-ice jacket complete with last name and provincial shield and two (2) on-ice shirts with last name at no cost, unless provided by the National Event.

- Juvenile Men, Juvenile Women:
  - o Team members and approved certified coaches will be provided one (1) on-ice jacket complete with last name and provincial shield and two (2) on-ice shirts with last name at no cost, unless provided by the National Event.
  - o Teams would receive the following additional funding to attend the U-18 International Championship
    - U-18 International held in Saskatchewan - \$500/team
    - U-18 International held in Alberta or Manitoba - \$1000/team
    - U-18 International held in any other province/territory - \$2000/team
- Mixed Doubles:
  - o Team members and coach (if applicable) can purchase on-ice jackets and on-ice shirts at cost for the event. They would be provided the provincial back shield at no cost.
  - o Teams would receive the following additional funding to attend the Canadian Mixed Doubles
    - Canadian Mixed Doubles held in Saskatchewan - \$500/team
    - Canadian Mixed Doubles held in Alberta or Manitoba - \$1000/team
    - Canadian Mixed Doubles held in any other province/territory - \$1250/team
- CURLSASK Provincial Winning Champion Teams who do not advance to represent Saskatchewan at a National Championship can purchase on-ice jackets and on-ice shirts at cost. They would be provided the provincial back shield at no cost.

### **Associate Members Champion Teams**

- Associate Members who send Provincial Team(s) to a recognized National Championship sanctioned by their National Organization, will be allowed to purchase CURLSASK official provincial team on-ice jackets, back crests and on-ice shirts at the designated price set by the Executive Director
