C-13 Alternate Players Policy

PURPOSE:

- To provide direction for teams, officials, administration and host committees of the CURLSASK stance on alternate players.

POLICY:

According to the rules of CURLSASK that govern competitions, teams consist of only four players. Teams are allowed to have a substitute or replacement players provided they comply with CURLSASK rules for substitution or replacement as outlined in the Competition Policy.

1. Alternate players are not recognized in CURLSASK competitions at any level.
2. Alternate players who attend a provincial championship do so at their own expense. Alternate players are not given ice access, do not march in ceremonies, are not recognized with the team at any functions, and do not receive any awards from the provincial sponsor.
3. As per Curling Canada's guidelines that Provincial teams going to the National Women's and National Men's take an alternate player, at the conclusion of the Women's Provincial Championship and the Men's Provincial Championship, the championship team must confirm an alternate player to travel with the team to the National Championship.

Alternate players that are named for the Men's and Women's National Competitions must be a resident of Saskatchewan (as per CURLSASK Residency Policy) and a current member of a CURLSASK affiliated club.
