2004 marks the 100th year of the Saskatchewan Curling Association and organized curling in Saskatchewan. The Anniversary planning committees wanted to find ways to celebrate this milestone in Curling history, as well as honour and preserve the memory of the many great players and supporters of the game and thus, the **SCA Legends of Curling, A Legacy of the SCA 100th Anniversary**, was born.

This inaugural year of the SCA Legends of Curling will see **all the Saskatchewan curling teams that have won a National title** as inductees. Saskatchewan Curling teams have won a total of 61 national titles and some of these teams have duplicated their national wins. The Inaugural Induction reception will see 52 teams being recognized for their accomplishments on the ice. Details for the reception are as follows:

Tom Naylen, SCA Past President and Chairman of the Legends Committee indicates that there has been outstanding response from the 52 teams being honoured, and is confident that the afternoon will be memorable, not only for the inductees, but also for the autograph seeking curling fan! **Kevin Waugh**, Saskatoon radio personality, is Master of Ceremonies for the presentations program and **Sylvia Fedoruk** and **Rick Folk** will have closing remarks on behalf of the inductees. Team categories include Mens, Womens, Juniors, Seniors and Mixed National championship teams.

In the years to come, it is the intention of the SCA Legends Honour Roll to honour the talents and dedication of Saskatchewan curling athletes, builders of the game as well as outstanding supporters and local legends. Following the announcement of the SCA Legends in April of 2003, many interested parties and curling clubs submitted names for consideration and these individuals are still eligible for recognition. Following this inaugural year, the Legends committee plans to develop guidelines that will form the foundation for future inductions while also accepting new nominations. All aspects of the great game and **“Official Sport of Saskatchewan”** will be eligible for recognition.
