## **Head Ice Technician Job Description/Responsibilities**

The Ice Technician is responsible for the day-to-day ice operations and maintaining a high standard of playing conditions expected in a private club environment. The season runs from approximately September 1<sup>st</sup> to April 30<sup>th</sup> each season.

The Head Ice Technician shall work with the Curling Manager on a regular basis and provide an ice maintenance schedule to ensure a smooth transition between draws, bonspiels and special events. The Head Ice Technician is expected to oversee the maintenance operation of the entire ice/rink and all aspects of the curling plant. The Chief Operating Officer shall oversee the employment of the Head Ice Technician and set their responsibilities.
