- Daily ice and facility maintenance for all curling activities.
- Ice maintenance to meet O.C.A. competitive curling standards.
- Train, supervise and schedule part-time helpers.
- Removal of ice, decal cleaning and equipment at end of season.
- Provide safe storage, cleaning of the facility, and protection of the curling equipment for the off season.
